

## **CO APCD Tips and Tricks**

Present on Admission Code (POA\_Cd) in the Medical\_Claims\_Dx table

Subject: Present on Admission Code (POA\_Cd) in the Medical\_Claims\_Dx table

Description: POA\_Cd indicating the presence of diagnosis at the time of admission

## DSG 12 Values:

- I = Exempt from POA reporting
- N = Diagnosis was not present at time of inpatient admission
- U = Documentation insufficient to determine if condition was present at time of inpatient admission
- W = Clinically undetermined
- Y = Diagnosis was present at time of inpatient admission

**Invalid Codes**: Some records have POA\_Cd values (e.g. POA\_Cd = "0", "M", "66", etc.) that are not listed in Table B. I.G in DSG.

The POA\_Cd values of "0", "M", "66" are present in the data but not valid codes according to the current CO APCD Data Submission Guide (DSG).

Because POA\_Cd is specific to admissions, it applies to inpatient claims only. Applying a filter of Claim\_Type\_Cd=I (inpatient claims) from the Medical\_Claims\_Header table and joining to the Medical\_Claims\_Dx table by Claim\_Id, CIVHC determined that a very small number of inpatient claims have invalid POA\_Cd values, primarily in older data. These claims include POA\_Cd "M", "53", and "0". POA\_Cd 66 is not found on any inpatient claims. The CIVHC recommendation is to exclude these claims from any analysis relying on the specific question of whether or not the diagnosis was present at the time of inpatient admission.
