

#### **Consumer Input for Facility Price Report**



#### Held two in-depth facility price focus groups with previous design/display

- Led to going down the path to display bundled pricing
- Patients want to understand quality and methodology, more information in links for those wanting to dig deeper
- Liked having the cost calculator option

#### Reviewed literature and learned from other best practices

- Simplified star ratings for quality, searchable by things that matter most to the consumer (quality, distance, price, etc.)
- Opted not to have "my cost" calculator based on experience from HSRI/NORC
- Conducted overall website design testing with consumers to ensure they understood where to go to access data on the website


