WHEREAS, it is estimated that only one in three US adults completes any type of advance directive for end-of-life care, and even fewer have written descriptions of the type of care they want if incapacitated and in need of medical care; and

WHEREAS, written directives can alleviate unnecessary suffering, improve quality of life, and support adults at any age or stage of health in understanding and sharing their personal values, life goals, and preferences regarding future medical care; and

WHEREAS, advance healthcare planning is not just for those who are facing end of life or terminal illness; and

WHEREAS, The Survivorship and Palliative Care Task Force of the Colorado Cancer Coalition supports individuals in getting the planning and care tools that they need;
